Biographical Sketch

Steve Warfel is a descendant of mid-18th century Pennsylvania German immigrants and a native of York, PA. He has conducted archaeological investigations on prehistoric and historic period sites for the past forty-seven years. Steve holds undergraduate and graduate degrees in Anthropology (BA, Franklin & Marshall College, 1971; MA, Brown University, 1980) and was The State Museum of Pennsylvania's Senior Curator of Archaeology from 1980 until retirement in June 2007. He is presently an archaeological consultant and recently supervised investigations at historic period sites in York, Lancaster, Cumberland, and Adams counties.

From 1991 through 2003, Steve instructed archaeology field school classes for college-age students at Ephrata Cloister, Eckley Miners' Village, Fort Augusta, and the Joseph Priestley House and Laboratory. He is a former president of The Society for Pennsylvania Archaeology and has authored numerous journal articles and publications.
